



# Hidden In The Hills Artist Studio Tour

## **Volunteer Service Requirement For Artists ~ Hidden In The Hills Artist Studio Tour**

All participating artists in the Hidden In The Hills Artist Studio Tour are required to complete 8 volunteer service hours for the Sonoran Arts League during the calendar year 2025. These hours must be fulfilled between Jan. 1, 2025, and Dec. 31, 2025.

If you choose not to fulfill these volunteer hours, you may opt to pay \$50 per unfulfilled hour. Payment may be made upfront or no later than Dec. 31, 2025.

***\*\*NEW THIS YEAR\*\* If payment is not received by Dec. 31, 2025 a \$100 penalty will be applied, if billing is required.***

### **Qualified acceptable volunteer hours:**

- Signing up for a position via the [Sonoran Arts League Volunteer Calendar](#).
- Being an active member of a committee or member of the board.
- Assisting a committee member, board member, or League office staff with an assigned task. Upon completing said task, the assigning member must submit an email signing off on the artist's task. Email must be submitted to the HITH Committee, at [HITHNewsletter@SonoranArtsLeague.org](mailto:HITHNewsletter@SonoranArtsLeague.org).
- If an artist spouse/partner signs up for volunteer opportunities via our events page those hours may go toward an artist's required 8 hours.
- Foothills Food Bank Empty Bowls fundraiser by participating in Empty Bowls studio workshops or by creating a minimum of 32 of bowls.

### **What does not count:**

- Teaching a Kiwanis sponsored or any class in the Studio, unless you donate your pay to the League.
- Any activities related to a host studio for the Hidden In The Hills Artist Studio Tour.
- Handing out HITH Directories, unless it is part of an assigned opportunity by a HITH committee member.
- Any activity not listed on the Sonoran Arts League Volunteer Calendar or assigned by a committee member, board member, or League office staff requires prior approval from the HITH Committee.
